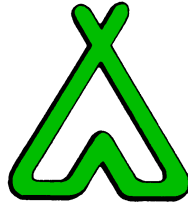


# Welcome to Summer 2017 at Camp St. Charles!



## Check-In Procedures:

1. Check in with the Director. Laura Hall, or another member of the Leadership team, in the chapel. You will be directed to see the Camp Nurse if your child takes any medications, if there is something incomplete on your medical forms, or if you like to speak with her. Bring all prescription and over the counter medications to be turned in. No medications are permitted in the cabins.
2. Go to your child's cabin and select a bed. Meet the counselors that will be working with your child in the cabin and discuss any concerns or special needs. If you are not sure which cabin your child will be living in, see the counselors in ANY cabin. The girls' cabins are 1, 2 and 3, near the mess hall. The boys' cabins are located behind the mess hall building, Cabins 4, 5 and 6 (by pool).
3. You are all finished! Feel free to check out the grounds a bit before you leave. The camp store will have t-shirts, postcards and other camp goodies for sale in the mess hall. We ask all parents to leave by 3 pm so that we can get started. It is very normal for your child to be a little nervous when you are leaving, we will help them to feel at right at home!

## Other Reminders:

To send mail to your child, be sure to allow plenty of time for the mail to reach him/her.

## 2017 Visiting Sunday Information

12 pm-5 pm          June 25, July 9, July 23 and August 6

Please do not turn onto Stella Maris Drive prior to 11:45 am, the gate will be locked and activities will still be happening. In the past, parents have driven onto the fields during sports activities, which is unsafe. We ask that you wait on 257 if you arrive early so that residents of Stella Maris Drive can get in and out and won't be blocked in by parents who are waiting to visit.

Mass will be celebrated at noon, all are welcome to join. **All children will assemble on the basketball court. Please meet your children there.** We celebrate Mass at the campfire area near the animals. Attendance at mass is encouraged by not required. Please do not visit the animals during mass.

1 pm- Meet with your child's counselors! All counselors will be at their cabins from 1-1:30pm.

You may sign out your child for the day in the mess hall. Only parents and those who have a child custody form on file at camp will be permitted to sign out campers. (Please have photo id)

You are encouraged to bring a picnic lunch (or pre-order a chicken dinner using form from folder) and enjoy the day with us at Camp. You may enjoy the swimming pool (water shoes are encouraged for all), rowboating , SUP and canoeing at the dock and fishing from the left side of the dock and giant swing rides. We ask parents and other visitors to abide by the same rules that we have set for our campers. (Everyone must wear a lifejacket on the dock)

## 2017 Two Week Session Check Out **Saturday** Information

Sign out your camper at their cabin. Finish the brief survey.

Pick up medications and/or see the Camp Nurse in the picnic area.

You may also stop in to see the Camp Director, Laura Hall, in the picnic area to receive your group photo and goody bag. If your child is interested in joining the Mentor program in 2017, be sure to ask for an info sheet.

Stop by the flag pole area to see if any of your child's things are in the lost and found area. After the last camper leaves, unclaimed items will be donated to the poor.

Early and Late checks out are difficult for us to accommodate. Most campers will be picked up at or near 10am. We ask that you only request early or late pick up when it is necessary.
